USC 2021-Education, Culture, Art, Science, and Sports (EDUCARSS), is a non-profit program organized by the [Office of International Affairs](#), UNESA. The purpose of USC 2021 is to develop young people's international perspective and promote UNESA and Indonesia, especially East Java Province and Surabaya. The ultimate goal of this program is to encourage students to recognize the diversity of the world societies and give them opportunities to experience different cultures.

PURPOSE OF PLAN

In the past decade, the Indonesia government has been encouraging students from all over the world to broaden their knowledge about Indonesia, and provide opportunities to experience different cultures. 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SUMMER COURSE INFORMATION

1. Online learning platform will be provided by Unesa
 2. To apply, prospective participants must submit a short video about their home culture and motivation to engage in the summer course
 3. Participants must participate for the entire duration of the program except for health complications or other unexpected conditions. USC-EDUCARSS 2021 will issue LoA, transcript, and certificate of participation to those participants.
 4. Participants may choose one of the summer course topic based on their interest. However, final topic allocation will be determined by the organizer.
 5. To be able to earn course credit, participants are required to submit a reflection journal and conduct group presentation at the end of the program.
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APPLICATION

Application Period opens on April 1 to May 1, 2021. Applications must be received by office of International affair UNESA by email or website (international_office@unesa.ac.id) (oia.unesa.ac.id) Application forms can downloaded from (oia.unesa.ac.id).

Please submit the completed application package to the **USC-EDUCARSS 2021** Website no later than 1 May 2021.

Seats are limited to **60 participants**.

CANDIDATE REQUIREMENTS

1. University Student.
 2. Must be proficient in English.
 3. In good health.
 4. Interested to learn Indonesian culture.
 5. Highly motivated.
 6. Willingness to participate for the entire duration of the program except for health complications or other unexpected conditions.
 7. Good interpersonal and communication skills.
 8. Students who actively participates in student government or after school activities such as clubs, sports, or community service project will be prioritized.
